Requirements & Rules

Requirements to Participate

EAHSBT is Sanctioned by B.A.S.S and allows us to Qualify anglers to the Bassmaster High School National Championship.

The total number of possible qualifiers to Nationals will be based on the number of unique boats/anglers list provided to and membership verified by B.A.S.S. The final number of possible qualifiers will not be determined until after all 4 tournaments and verification from B.A.S.S. EAHSBT AOY points will determine the order of B.A.S.S. National Championship qualifiers.

To be eligible:

- Anglers must have their B.A.S.S. National and State Memberships, Team Roster up to date and provide their B.A.S.S. membership ID# on EAHSBT registration.
- If Angler does not have updated membership and on a school/ team roster they WILL NOT be able to qualify for Nationals.
- EAHSBT will not be responsible or liable for any inaccurate membership reporting. This is the sole responsibility of the Angler (B.A.S.S. will verify your membership)
- Qualifications for Nationals will be determined based on EAHSBT AOY Points.
- All 2 Angler teams must be paired with Anglers from SAME
 SCHOOL and be in the 8th-12th grade to qualify for Nationals
- 7th grade and under are allowed to fish in EAHSBT Junior Division, but WILL NOT be able to qualify for Nationals.
- If you pair a Junior Angler and High School Angler, they cannot qualify for B.A.S.S. Nationals.
- You DO NOT have to be registered in Alabama to participate or qualify. Other states can participate/qualify but MUST HAVE their B.A.S.S. National & State membership and Team roster updated and active.
- NO Substitution of Partners will be allowed. If one partner cannot fish, the remaining partner must fish alone to maintain AOY Points. Any changes in partners will not count towards original team Points.

RULES to Participate

EAHSBT is open to all school age anglers.

High School Division (8th—12th Grade)
Junior Division (7th Grade and Under)

Team Format—2 Student Anglers* and Boat Captain**

- *2 Students fishing together must be from the same school. A student may also be permitted to fish alone if there are no other students from the same school who wish to participate, however the angler must still have a boat captain that CANNOT Fish. High school and Junior anglers can fish together if in same district. Anglers MUST wear life jacket while main motor running.
- ** Boat Captain must be 18 years of age. Tournament director reserves the right to make allowance on boat captain age requirement in special cases. Only the boat captain is allowed to operate the Main Motor. Students are allowed to assist in loading/unloading. Kill switch and life jackets must be worn at all times if the main motor is running. BOAT CAPTAIN CANNOT FISH! Captain can operate Trolling motor and net fish in the Junior division only,.
- All boats must maintain a minimum of \$100,000 boating liability insurance
- Anglers must have valid fishing/vessel license based on federal/state regulations.
- \$20 per angler, per tournament
- Registrations must be received one week prior to tournament date, or late fee will be due. You can email or mail registrations.
- Boats must be equipped with working live well and proper navigation lights.
- 5 fish limit, Only 5 fish allowed in live well at any time.
 No Culling at the Ramp.
- Size limits will be announced at the launch sites.
 Short fish penalty is -1 lb, and will not be weighed.
 Dead fish penalty per fish, no culling dead fish:
 1(-.25);2(-.75); 3(-1.25); 4(-1.75): 5(-2.25)
- NO live bait or trolling
- Don't be late, 1lb per minute penalty
