TOURNAMENT RULES:

1. One or two man tournament. Bring your own partner.

2. Five fish limit per boat (largemouth, spotted, & redeye). Only fish measuring 12 inches (mouth closed) will count towards your total weigh-in. If a fish measuring less than 12 inches is brought to scales, the team's largest fish will be culled. Golden rule. Pinch tail. 5. No trolling.

3. Artificial baits only will be allowed. 4. Only one rod at a time per person may be used.

6. There will be 2 oz penalty for each bass weighed in dead. No culling of dead fish. All live fish will be released.

7. Any teams that are late to the weigh in will be penalized 1 lb per minute, 15 min maximum.

8. The tournament will start at safe light & end at 2:00 PM sharp (Unless entry numbers require 2 flites).

9. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in boat during tournament.

10. Gross unsportsmanlike conduct is grounds for disgualification. Determination by Tournament Committee.

11. Participants subject to polygraphic test.

12. Life jackets must be worn when big engine is running. Kill switch required.

13. Contestants must not leave tournament water during tournament except with permission (emergency)

14. Boats will be flighted in the order entry fees are received. Drop-ins are welcome the morning of the tournament starting at 4 AM.
